
Expandable Sleeve





LANGOFLEX PET is a tough, lightweight expandable sleeving made of PET .010" (0.25mm) monofilaments braided into a cylindrical sleeve.

LANGOFLEX PET provides excellent abrasion and good mechanical properties. The flexible open braid construction allows each size to expand up to three times its original diameter for easy installation over irregular shapes. This construction also provides complete drainage preventing heat, condensation and moisture.

LANGOFLEX PET is also available in a dense (LANGOFLEX PET-D) and high-density (LANGOFLEX PET-HD) construction, offering a good choice for every application need.

LANGOFLEX PET is designed to protect tubes, hoses, wires, wire bundles, wire harnesses, cable assemblies and flat ribbon cables without adding critical weight, bulk and extra cost.

The good chemical resistance of the polyester material makes it ideal for harsh environments, it is then well suited for automotive applications.


